

SUMMARY

A flexible, unit-by-unit remote training initiative for learners wanting support to help them achieve their Advanced Diploma in Insurance (ACII) qualification.

- Learners can get support for all five units needed for ACII over 30 months
- Equally, learners can get support for the individual units they are studying outside a fixed programme.

ACII TRAINING STRUCTURE

Remote training is based on three two-and-a-half-hour discussion sessions covering key topics relevant to the unit in question – plus over-arching guidance on writing ACII assignments in terms of structure, content and market expectations. There will be training on two different units every six months, offering learners a choice of pathway towards their ACII
