

SUMMARY & INTRODUCTION

A flexible, unit-by-unit remote training initiative for learners wanting support to help them achieve their Diploma in Insurance (Dip CII) qualification.

- Learners can get support for all four units needed for Dip CII over two years, beginning with either M05 Insurance law or M92 Insurance business and finance, with a choice of future units.
- Equally, learners can get support for the individual units they are studying outside a fixed programme.

DIP CII TRAINING STRUCTURE

Remote training on each Diploma unit is as follows:

5 x 3-hour sessions (every 1 or 2 weeks)	Detailed explanation of each textbook chapter (including end-of-chapter questions)
6-week break for drafting of the Diploma assignment	
2 x 3-hour sessions	Revision sessions based on mock exams and revision quizzes

All sessions are recorded so learners can re-listen as part of their studies (audio versions are also available)

In addition to the 21 hours of training time and the recorded sessions, all learners will be provided with a broad set of training and revision materials for each unit:
